Help for Members of St. Paul's in Need

In the late 1990s (sometime after the start of Milton McGuirt's appointment in 1997), a fund was set up to be used exclusively to help St. Paul's members in need. This special fund—called "The Helping Hand Fund"—is separate from the church's operating moneys and is supported completely by donated gifts, not by the church budget.

The Helping Hand Fund is designed to provide aid to our members in their time of personal hardship, tragedy or catastrophe—and when that need is beyond the member's and their immediate family's resources, capability or other resources.

The fund is administered on a very confidential basis so there is no need for anyone who needs help to be embarrassed about requesting it. Furthermore, names are not recorded. Generally, help has been provided to pay bills such as utilities, rent and extraordinary medical expenses. Help from the fund is not intended to provide on-going or sustained assistance, but as a supplement and/or temporary aid to bridge issues.
